



Tax Payments with Online Banking


Click on the **Pay & Transfer** tab on your dashboard




Click on Tax Payment



Select the From account



- Select the IRD Registration Office this is where you were registered as a tax payer
- Select the IRD Bank Account based on the type of tax you are paying: Main, VAT or Amnesty
- Select the Tax Type
- Enter your Tax Identification Number
 (TIN) you'll find this on your Tax
 registration document. E.g. 0123456-01-1
 (only enter the first 7-8 digits).
 Newer TINs have 8 digits
- Select the Payment Type Account or Tax Period payment
- If Tax Period Payment is selected, specify the Year and Period e.g. 2019-01



- Enter My reference this is your reference on your bank statement
- Enter the Amount

- On the Review page, confirm that all details are correct and click on Pay
- The 19 digit Tax Reference Number (TRN)
 is system generated based on the
 selections and inputs on the Payments
 page. The Ministry of Finance uses this
 reference, received from the Bank,
 to allocate the payment
